Opportunities for writing

Chapter 1

Children are to write a scene, as either Agatha or Lenny, where they imagine their own scene of chaos that is unleased on Little Strangehaven.

Alternatively, they can write as themselves and base it in their own school.

Chapter 23

Children write a story where they are being attacked my gargoyles or some other monsters in their school.

Chapter 32
